"Jordan Du Haime's piece Untitled II struck me with its architectural simplicity. Clean lines resulting in sharp shadows, gives a large amount of depth to the work. The two columns that seem to possibly represent the Roman numeral II, that for which the piece is named, questions the viewer to give more importance to a seemingly simple architectural element. Rename the piece and this element serves solely a visual purpose. A clever way to incorporate a title into a clean and simplistic form. The object takes on a life of its own, sitting as a whole structure in almost a Brancusi-esq moment. 
